Dear Parents and Carers,

Subject: Temporary Uniform Change Due to Hot Weather

I am writing to inform you that, in light of the exceptionally hot weather forecast for next week, we have made the decision to temporarily adjust our uniform policy. Our top priority is the comfort, health, and well-being of our students during this period of high temperatures.

Starting from **Monday 22nd June**, all students (Yr 7 - 11) should attend school wearing their **CWS HRF uniform** in place of their academic uniform.

Year 12 students should still continue to wear business attire, however do not need to wear a tie, jumper, jacket and top buttons can be undone.

For Curriculum Enhancement day on **Tuesday 23rd June**, please follow any previous guidance with regards to dress code and uniform requirements. To help us maintain a smart and safe environment, please ensure your child adheres to the standard HRF kit expectations (official CWS HRF t-shirt, shorts/skort, and appropriate trainers). Casual sportswear, non-school hoodies, or open-toed shoes are not permitted.

Important Health & Safety Reminders

To help students manage the heat, please ensure they come to school prepared each day with the following essentials:

- **Refillable Water Bottle:** Students will have access to water stations before school and at break and lunch and should ensure they are filling up their bottles during these times.
- **Sun Cream:** Please ensure sun cream is applied before arriving at school. Students may also bring a bottle to reapply during break times.

Next Steps and Review

We will keep this arrangement in place for the duration of the week. This decision will be formally reviewed on **Friday 26th June**, and any updates or plans to revert back to standard school uniform expectations for the following week will be communicated to you before the weekend.
